Rules

- No throwing candy or any other objects. **(For Safety Reasons)**
 - No Signs, Shirts, Flyers or Hand-outs stating: "Running for...", "Elect...", "Candidate for...", etc.. These and any similar words are **strictly** prohibited.
 - Political banners are **not** permitted. **This is not a political parade.**
 - Current office holders may have signs stating their name and office only.
 - Remember the reason of this occasion, honoring the members of the United States Armed Forces, past and present.
 - Obey the instructions of the Legion volunteers and others helping with staging and traffic control.
 - Please display the flag whenever possible and do so with reverence and respect.
- Any violation of the above may result in immediate removal from the Parade and no Parade participation the following year(s).**
- Keep up with the pace of the parade.
 - **Have fun, be courteous and be safe.**
