Vietnam 50-year Anniversary

We have many members that served in Vietnam. Although your reception may have not been what was expected, do know that we love you. You are amongst friends here. Welcome home!

According to Military. Com there are four important things to know about Vietnam Vets:

- 1. Most Vietnam War Veterans Were Volunteers.
 - a. Out of all the people on active duty at the time, only <u>2.2 million were drafted</u>, and only 25% of the total number of troops in combat zones were drafted.
- 2. It Was the First Major Conflict Fought by a Fully Integrated Military.
 - a. By the time the United States began increasing its involvement in South Vietnam, American military units were fully integrated, with an estimated 340,000 African Americans, 80,000 Latinos, 42,000 Native Americans and 35,000 Asian Americans serving in Vietnam.
- 3. There Are Still Service Members Missing in Action in Vietnam.
 - a. Since the end of the war and the repatriation of American prisoners of war in 1973, the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency has recovered or identified 1,062 of those. That means 1,584 U.S. service members are still waiting to come home.

- 4. Vietnam Veterans Today Are Largely Like Any Other American.
 - a. An estimated 30% of Vietnam veterans suffered from post-traumatic stress disorder during their lifetime, according to the 1988 National Vietnam Veterans Readjustment Study, the last time such a study was done. Still, 97% of Vietnam vets hold honorable discharges, and the <u>unemployment rate for veterans of the Vietnam War</u> was only 4.8% in 1987, compared to the 6.2% rate for the rest of America.
